Charlie's Story

In Year 3, Charlie was having terrible problems with literacy.

His difficulties were becoming more and more apparent, and according to dad, Graham, he was getting frustrated and 'stroppy'. He started tuition with Genie and over the course of Year 4, made tremendous progress.

Over the course of Year 4, he progressed enormously. We have a friend who's a headmistress and she independently confirmed to us just how impressive his progress has been. He's now where he should be in both English and Maths and we've been told he'll hit his targets in both subjects.

His handwriting is brilliant now and he loves going to his sessions, probably because his confidence has improved so much.



We couldn't bear the thought of Charlie going to his next school and not being able to keep up. We're going to stay with Genie until he takes his SATs at the end of Year 6 and then we'll re-evaluate his needs when he moves up a year.

Why do you need a tutor?
